NOTICE OF FILING JOINT

PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On July 28, 2006, the Administrative Law Judge issued a Prodecural Order that directed Eschelon Telecom of Arizona, Inc. ("Eschelon") and Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") to submit a joint proposed procedural schedule. Thereafter, counsel for Eschelon, Qwest and Commission Staff discussed a mutually acceptable pretrial and hearing schedule and on August 4, 2006 counsel reached an agreement on a new proposed schedule.

Importantly, this new proposed schedule is contingent upon counsel for Eschelon and Qwest being successful in pushing out the dates currently set for Qwest-Eschelon interconnection agreement arbitrations in Colorado, Oregon and Utah to accommodate the new procedural schedule proposed in this docket at a time when Mr. Steese is available. Counsel will be working together this week to secure new schedules in those cases. In the event counsel are unable to agree upon later arbitration dates in the other cases and thus a schedule in this case, counsel will advise the Administrative Law Judge no later than August 11, 2006.


1 The new procedural schedule approved by counsel for Eschelon, Qwest, and Staff, subject

8 Qwest and Staff have indicated that Eschelon may file this schedule on behalf of the Parties. As
9 Mr. Steese is on vacation this week, Eschelon agreed to make the filing. Again, the foregoing
10 schedule is contingent upon rescheduling arbitrations in other states and the parties will advise
11 whether they are prepared to have the new schedule considered and adopted in this docket on or
12 before August 11, 2006.
