Dear Ms. O'Connor:

Based upon our meeting of March 22, 2004 I am writing to issue you an exclusion from the requirements of the Arizona Administrative Code (AAC) R18-4-505, Approval to Construct (ATC). The exclusion authority can be found in AAC R18-4-112.

AAC R18-4-505 requires a water system to obtain an ATC prior to commencing any construction which will modify an existing drinking water facility. During our meeting we determined that the construction activity for the Park Water Company well required an ATC. This requirement was not met by Park Water Company, however the Department is hereby issuing an exclusion from the ATC requirement for 90 days from the date of this letter. This 90 day exclusion from the requirements of R18-4-505 is conditioned on the following.

1. Park Water Company is to conduct Total Coliform monitoring in the distribution system twice a month for the term of this exemption.
2. Park Water Company is to conduct weekly chlorine residual monitoring in various portions of the water system weekly to ensure a minimum chlorine residual (measured as free chlorine, combined chlorine, or chlorine dioxide) of 0.2 milligrams per liter (mg/l). Please refer to the attached distribution system sketch for sampling locations.
3. Park Water Company will ensure that the minimum chlorine residual in the distribution system is at least 0.2 mg/l at all times.
4. Park Water Company is to immediately notify the Department of any positive Total or Fecal/E-Coli positive samples and any chlorine residual measurements below 0.2 mg/l by calling (602) 771-4617.


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While this exclusion is in place Park Water Company is permitted to utilize the modified well. If at any time any of the above conditions are not met Park Water Company is to immediately cease use of the modified well until further notice from the Department.

Park Water Company is directed to make all efforts to obtain the services of a Professional Engineer to provide the required plans and specifications necessary for issuance of the ATC for the modified well during the effective time of this exclusion (please reference the application deficiency letter from the Department dated February 12, 2004). If Park Water Company has not submitted the required documents to allow processing of the ATC by the Department by the end of the effective period of this exclusion, an extension to the exclusion will be considered. Your efforts during this exclusion period to address the application deficiencies will factor into any extension decision made by the Department.

I would encourage you to consult with the Department on future construction projects to ensure all permitting requirements are met. ## Water Quality Division APPROVAL OF CONSTRUCTION

Project Description: Deepen Park Water Company Well No. 1 from 650 feet to 800 feet.

Location: Town of Florence, Pinal County.

Project Owner: Patricia O'Connor, Park Water Co., P. O. Box 16173, Phx, AZ 85011.

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) hereby issues an Approval of Construction for the above described facility based on the following provisions of the Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) R18-5-507 et seq.

On October 21, 2004, ADEQ issued a Certificate of Approval to Construct for the referenced project.

On November 04, 2004, Certificate of Completion and testing results were submitted to ADEQ.

On November 1, 2004, Lisa J. Farrington, P.E. certified the following:

- a final construction inspection was conducted on June 6, 2004,
- the referenced project was constructed according to the approved plans and specifications and ADEQ's Certificate of Approval to Construct;
- water system pressure and leakage tests were conducted, and the results were within the allowable leakage rates;
- the water distribution system was disinfected according to an ADEQ-approved method; and
- microbiological samples were collected, and analyzed, and the sample results were negative for total coliform.

This Approval of Construction authorizes the owner to begin operating the above-described facilities as represented in the approved plans on file with ADEQ. Be advised that A.A.C. § R18-5-124 requires the owner of a public water system to maintain and operate all water production, treatment and distribution facilities in accordance with ADEQ Safe Drinking Water Rules.
