PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 15, 2006, DIECA Communications, Inc., doing business as Covad Communications Company and Mountain Telecommunications, Inc., Eschelon Telecom of Arizona, Inc., McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc., and XO Communications Services, Inc. (collectively "Applicants" or "Joint CLECs") filed a request with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") to address key unbundled network element ("UNE") issues arising from the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") Triennial Review Remand Order ("TRRO"), including approval of Qwest Wire Center Lists.

A procedural conference was conducted on May 1, 2006 and, on May 30, 2006, the parties made a Joint Filing Regarding Procedural Matters addressing the items discussed at the May 1, 2006 procedural conference.

By Procedural Order issued June 2, 2006, a hearing was scheduled for October 19, 20, and 23, 2006, a procedural schedule was established for filing testimony, and a Protective Order was issued to protect confidential information from disclosure.

On July 26, 2006, the Applicants filed a Motion to Compel, seeking an order compelling Qwest to provide wire center data as of the end of 2004. The Joint CLECs state that Qwest objected

1 to providing line count data updated through March 2005, or through December 31, 2004 if the
 2 March 2005 data is not available. The Applicants contend that, for purposes of determining whether
 3 impairment exists in a particular wire center, the FCC's TRRO¹ defines business lines as incumbent
 4 local exchange carrier ("ILEC") "ARMIS 43-08 business lines, plus business UNE-P, plus UNE-
 5 loops," but does not specify the date on which the line counts were to be made. The Joint CLECs
 6 claim that because the effective date of the TRRO is March 11, 2005, the impairment determination
 7 should be based on data contemporaneous with that date (or, at a minimum, as of the end of 2004).
 8 In support of its position, the Applicants cite to a decision by the Michigan Public Service
 9 Commission requiring SBC Michigan to use 2004 ARMIS data², as well as Bellsouth's use of
 10 updated December 2004 ARMIS data to establish wire center impairment³. On July 27, 2006, the
 11 Joint CLECs filed a Supplement to Motion to Compel in the form of a ruling by an Administrative
 12 Law Judge at the Oregon Public Utility Commission granting a motion to compel production of data
 13 that is being sought in Arizona (December 2004 line count data)⁴. On August 3, 2006, the Joint
 14 CLECs filed a Second Supplement to Motion to Compel in the form of an Interim Order of an
 15 Administrative Law Judge at the Public Utilities Commission of Colorado which granted a motion to
 16 compel production of the December 2004 line count data⁵.

17 On August 7, 2006, Qwest filed a Response in Opposition to the Joint CLECs' Motion to
 18 Compel. Qwest argues that the information sought by the Applicants is not relevant to this
 19 proceeding because the FCC's analysis in the TRRO is based on the use of December 2003 ARMIS

1 data provided by Qwest and other ILECs to show wire centers that meet the FCC's non-impairment
2 criteria. Qwest asserts that the Joint CLECs are seeking new, additional data which would be
3 inconsistent with the FCC's impairment determination and which data would add nothing to the
4 probative value of determining the accuracy of the original non-impaired wire center list. Qwest cites
5 to decisions of state regulatory commissions in Washington⁶, Texas⁷, Ohio⁸, Indiana⁹, Illinois¹⁰, and
6 Rhode Island¹¹, which accepted the use of December 2003 wire center data for state impairment
7 determinations.

8 No specific determination is necessary at this time with respect to whether the Commission's
9 decision in this matter should be based on the 2003 or 2004 ARMIS data. However, for purposes of
10 discovery, the requested 2004 data appears "reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of
11 admissible evidence" pursuant to Rule 26(b) of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure.

12 On August 2, 2006, Qwest filed a Request for Procedural Modification. In its Request, Qwest
13 seeks to have the current hearing dates changed to October 26 and 27, 2006 to accommodate the
14 schedule of one of its witnesses. Qwest indicates that counsel for the Joint CLECs and Staff have
15 consented to the proposed change of the hearing dates. Qwest also asks that the Commission
16 establish a procedure to require parties on the service list to affirmatively state whether they intend to
17 actively participate in this proceeding or, at a minimum, to state whether they desire to receive copies
18 of pleadings and testimony. Qwest argues that only the CLECs named in the caption have
19 participated to date and it is wasteful to continue to send copies of filings to the extensive service list

1 that currently exists in this docket.

2 Given the agreement to change the hearing dates, the hearing will be rescheduled for October
3 26 and 27, 2006. In addition, administrative efficiency will be advanced by requiring parties
4 interested in remaining on the service list and continuing to receive filings in this docket to file an
5 affirmative indication of such an interest. Interested parties may continue to review all filings in the
6 docket by accessing the Commission's website at www.azcc.gov, and using the e-docket function.

7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Joint CLECs Motion to Compel is granted and
8 Qwest is directed to provide the requested December 2004 line count data as soon as possible, but no
9 later than 10 days from the effective date of this Procedural Order.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the **hearing in this matter shall be rescheduled for October**
11 **26 and 27, 2006, commencing at 9:30 a.m.**, at the offices of the Commission, 1200 West
12 Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that parties on the service list who wish to continue to receive
14 copies of filings in this docket shall file, by no later than August 31, 2006, an affirmative statement
15 indicating their interest in remaining on the service list and a current address where service of filings
16 should be sent. Failure to file an affirmative statement by August 31, 2006 will result in removal
17 from the service list in this docket.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rule 38(a) of the Rules of the
19 Arizona Supreme Court with respect to practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
21 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
22 Rules of Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes the obligation to
23 appear at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter
24 is scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by
25 the Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
27 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's
28 Decision in this matter is final and non-appeable.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
2 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
3 hearing.
