PROCEDURAL ORDER

13 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

14 On October 5, 2005, West End Water Company ("West End" or "Applicant") filed with the
15 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for an extension of its existing
16 Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate").

17 On February 3, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Letter of
18 Sufficiency.

19 On February 6, 2006, a procedural order was issued setting forth filing deadlines and a
20 hearing date in this matter.

21 On March 28, 2006, the City of Surprise ("Surprise") filed an Application for Leave to
22 Intervene. By procedural order, on April 18, 2006, Surprise was granted intervention.

23 On May 22 and 24, 2006, a hearing was convened before a duly appointed Administrative
24 Law Judge of the Commission.

25 By Procedural Order on May 25, 2006, the parties were ordered to file simultaneous closing
26 briefs no later than July 17, 2006, and to file simultaneous response briefs no later than July 31, 2006.

27 On July 14, 2006, by Procedural Order and at the request of the parties, the due dates for
28 closing and response briefs were postponed.

On July 18, 2006, Surprise docketed its Notice of Filing of Request for Service and Will
Serve Letter.

On July 21, 2006, Staff filed its Request to Suspend the Briefing Schedule and Re-Open
Hearing, stating that there were new factual questions relating to the request for service that should be

1 addressed at hearing.

2 On July 24, 2006, West End docketed its Joinder in Staff's Request to Suspend Briefing
3 Schedule and Re-Open Hearing. Surprise docketed its Response to Staff Request to Suspend
4 Briefing Schedule and Re-Open Hearing, wherein it objected to re-opening the hearing in this matter,
5 although it stated it had no objection to suspending the briefing schedule.

6 Accordingly, a procedural conference should be scheduled and the current briefing schedule
7 should be suspended.

8 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **procedural conference** in the above-captioned matter
9 shall be held on **August 2, 2006, at 9:00 a.m.** or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the
10 Commission's offices, 1200 W. Washington, Phoenix, Arizona.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the briefing schedule put in place by the July 14, 2006,
12 Procedural Order shall be, and hereby is, suspended.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the timeclock in this matter continues to be suspended.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
15 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
16 hearing.




