

Subject: Proposed Utility Rate Hikes by Citizens/UniSource

Dear Mr. Spitzer:

The Lake Havasu Unified School District No. 1 is submitting this letter to express our concern regarding utility rate hikes proposed by Citizens/UniSource. Following is an explanation of the District's financial situation and the possible impacts an increase on electric rates would have on students attending school in the Lake Havasu Unified School District.

No business likes to suffer, however most private businesses have a contingency fund to cover unexpected budget increases. The Lake Havasu Unified School District does not have this luxury. School districts are not income generators. Payment for these expenses comes out of the District's M&O budget. Looking ahead to the next fiscal year, the proposed 2003/2004 M & O budget for the Lake Havasu Unified School District is \$24,517,346, with projected expenditures currently totaling \$25,491,886. This, as you can see, results in a shortfall of \$974,540. Projected increases in the 2003/2004 budget, other than the proposed utility rate increase, include a 129% increase in Arizona State Retirement contribution, a 15-20% increase in costs for employee health insurance, increases in liability insurance due to 9/11, etc.

Our current year expenses for electric are projected at \$1,200,000.00. Excess Utilities, ARS 15-910, is an avenue the State passed into law years ago, to be used by School Districts to fund utility costs over the fiscal year budgeted amount. This cost, borne by the local taxpayer, was frozen at the amount used in 2002. The District's excess utilities amount is approximately \$33,000. This amount, as you can see, would not begin to cover the Citizens/ UniSource rate increase of 20% or 31% or 45%. Such dramatic increases will have an immediate negative impact on the quality of education that our children receive. The long range impact would be catastrophic for our community and our country.

Arizona ranks 49th out of 50 states in public education funding. A further lack of funds in the District's M&O budget would likely lead to increased class size,


reduction and elimination of critical programs, not to mention the exodus of high quality teachers. When class sizes go up, teachers begin to leave the system, discipline problems and school dropout increase, and effective teaching and learning decreases.

Lake Havasu Unified School District has one of the lowest per-pupil spending in the state. We do not have available sources of revenue like override, federal impact aid, Indian impact aid, desegregation funding, or career ladder funding. The lack of such funding availability contributes to the lowest overall per-pupil spending/revenue (Please see attached).

The proposed utility rate increase would have a devastating impact on our school system and the children that we serve.

Your consideration of this matter is highly appreciated, and the District, representing the children of Lake Havasu, thanks you.
