**PROCEDURAL ORDER**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On February 7, 2003, a Procedural Order was issued in this docket establishing a procedural schedule, including scheduling of a hearing date. The Procedural Order also directed the Joint Applicants to publish and mail notice to their customers, by March 10, 2003, in the form prescribed

1 in the Order.

2 On February 11, 2003, Local Union 769, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers,  
3 AFL-CIO ("IBEW Local 769") filed an Application to Intervene in this matter. IBEW Local 769  
4 states that it is directly and substantially affected by this proceeding because it is the exclusive  
5 representative of a large group of employees of Citizens Communications Company ("Citizens").  
6 IBEW Local 769 contends that its participation will not unduly broaden the scope of the issues  
7 presented in this case. On February 11, 2003, the Joint Applicants filed a Response stating that they  
8 have no objection to the request for intervention filed by IBEW Local 769.

9 On February 12, 2003, the Joint Applicants filed a Motion for Modification of the February 7,  
10 2003 Procedural Order ("Motion"). The Joint Applicants request that the mailing deadline be  
11 extended until March 20, 2003 to accommodate the ability of Citizens to complete mailing of the bill  
12 inserts for its entire billing cycle. The Motion states that the Joint Applicants will comply with the  
13 newspaper publication deadline of March 10, 2003.

14 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Application to Intervene filed by IBEW Local 769 is  
15 hereby granted.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the February 7, 2003 Procedural Order shall be modified to  
17 permit the Joint Applicants until March 20, 2003 to complete mailing of the required notice to  
18 customers. In all other respects, the February 7, 2003 Procedural Order shall remain in full force and  
19 effect.

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
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
