PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 16, 2005, Black Mountain Sewer Corporation ("Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission for a rate increase.

The evidentiary hearings in this matter commenced on June 7, 2006 and concluded on June 20, 2006. At the conclusion of the hearing, a briefing schedule was established and the time clock was extended by 30 days with the Company's consent. The schedule agreed to by the parties required initial briefs to be filed by August 14, 2006 and reply briefs to be filed by August 28, 2006.

On July 31, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff, the Company, the Town of Carefree, the Residential Utility Consumer Office and the Boulders Homeowners Association/Mr. Robert Williams jointly filed a Stipulation and Request for Procedural Order to Extend the Briefing Schedule. The parties request a one-week extension of the briefing schedule and the time clock.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED **initial briefs** shall be filed by **August 21, 2006** and **reply briefs** shall be filed by **September 5, 2006**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time clock shall be extended by an additional week.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.


