PROCEDURAL ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the request of ADOT shall be considered an application for the Railroad to upgrade an existing crossing pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-337, et seq.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Railroad shall be considered as the Respondent in this proceeding.




