Updated Information Regarding Teligent's Bankruptcy Proceedings

Teligent Services, Inc. ("Teligent") hereby files this Memorandum at the direction of ALJ Philip J. Dion in the above-referenced Procedural Order. In the Procedural Order, Teligent was ordered to provide updated information to the Arizona Corporation Commission no later than August 21, 2002 regarding the Bankruptcy Court Hearing initially scheduled for July 9, 2002 and rescheduled to August 14, 2002. The primary purpose of the August 14, 2002 hearing, as the Commission is aware, was the Bankruptcy Court's formal consideration of Teligent's second plan to emerge from bankruptcy through a Plan of Reorganization ("POR"). The POR, which was described to the Commission in Teligent's two related correspondences dated May 30, 2002¹ will enable Teligent to emerge from bankruptcy in its current corporate form with new funding thereby enabling it to continue providing its current services and to reintroduce other services which, as a result of its Chapter 11 status, it previously had to discontinue.

A condition precedent to the Bankruptcy Court approval of Teligent's POR is agreement by certain of Teligent's classes of creditors and claimants which, under the Bankruptcy Code, must agree to the POR prior to the Bankruptcy's Court's ability to approve it. In order to provide a short window of additional time upon which to obtain all necessary approvals, the August 14 Bankruptcy Court hearing to formally consider Teligent's POR was rescheduled to September 5, 2002. Thus, unless this further rescheduled hearing date is delayed, yet again (something Teligent deems unlikely), Teligent will not know until September 5, 2002 if the Court will be able to approve its second emergence plan.

Teligent will provide the Commission further updated information about the September 5, 2002 and the likelihood of the approval of its POR as soon as the Hearing occurs.


