
11 Any domestic, non-profit corporation or association, formed in whole or in part to promote conservation of

15 certification proceeding, shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for hearing, file with the
16 Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona 85007,
17 a notice of its intent to be a party.

18 The Committee or hearing officer, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other persons parties
19 to the proceedings.

20 Any person may make a limited appearance at the hearing by filing a statement in writing with the
21 Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona 85007,
22 not less than five (5) days before the date set for hearing. A person making a limited appearance shall not
23 be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine witnesses.

24 This proceeding is governed by A.R.S. § 40-360 to § 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code
25 Rules R14-3-201 to R14-3-219. The written decision of the Committee shall be submitted to the Arizona
26 Corporation Commission pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 40-360.07. Any person intending to
