

On October 1, 2003, Beaver Valley Water Company ("Applicant" or "Company") filed an application for approval of the sale of its assets and transfer of its CC&N.

On August 17, 2005, in Decision No. 68083, the Commission conditionally granted the sale of assets and the transfer of Beaver Valley's Certificate to Mr. Michael Davoren, a sole proprietor, subject to conditions. On April 13, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") opened a new docket (W-02015A-06-0223) and filed a Complaint and Order to Show Cause against BVWC citing failure to comply with Commission Decision Nos. 66388, 68083 and Arizona Administrative Code R14-2-411(D) (4). On April 21, 2006, Mr. Michael Davoren filed an Answer to the Complaint and Order to Show Cause.

On May 25, 2006, during Open Meeting and after discussions with the parties and a representative from Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, the Commission decided to reopen the record in this matter, pursuant to A.R.S. Section 40-252.

The application, report of the Commission's Utilities Division Staff, and any written exceptions to the Staff Report prepared by the Applicant are available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission located at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, and at the address of the Applicant at [address] and on the internet via the Commission website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-docket function.
