The reasons for delays are as follows. Almost immediately after the purchase of the property in question, my father had a severe stroke and was hospitalized in Chicago. I'd call in 18 to 20 days and leave a voice mail and get no response. I'd call back 2-3 days later and leave yet another voice mail and get no response. I would e-mail to check the status and get no response. I stopped by the office on a Friday and the note on the door said we left at 12:30 today. I stopped back on Monday requesting to speak to the engineer working on my development and he would not be in. I'd leave a message to have him call me and receive no call. I went back the next day and they said he left for 2 weeks vacation. All this nonsense has persisted during the entire process. Not just with the engincers but a couple other offices as well.

I purchased this property at preliminary plat approval. The engineer was already chosen. I felt it would be cost efficient to let them finish. I think they were just too busy to provide good customer service. I want more than anything to finalize this and get Final Plat Approval. I've worked very hard and have been very frustrated.

I would greatly appreciate if the Staff would grant me the extension so I may finish this project. I appreciate your consideration on this very important matter and promise to do all I can to expedite the process. We are very close at this time.


