I am opposed to the excessive (20%) rate increase that APS is applying for. The emergency rate increase previously given when natural gas prices were nearly twice as high as they are now should result in an adjustment.

Also, I noticed that the ACC staff is determined a rate adjustment of less than 10% for this docket and this should not be exceeded by the Commissioners (as has happened several times before). The lobbying effort of APS should be ignored (period).

The threat of the bonding agencies (probably with encouragement of APS until after this rate case) to lower the bond ratings of future debt, should not be considered by you Commissioners. This is purely artificial pressure noise.
