RE: **ADMINISTRATIVE CLOSURE - IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF AFFINITY NETWORK INCORPORATED FOR A CANCELLATION OF THEIR CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (DOCKET NO. T-02664A-03-0376)**

On July 9, 2003, Affinity Network Incorporated ("ANI") filed for approval to cancel its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N"). ANI later clarified that the application to cancel should apply only to its CC&N to provide local exchange telecommunications services. However, Staff had no record of issuance of a CC&N for local exchange telecommunications services to ANI. Nor did Staff have any record of an application by ANI to obtain a CC&N for local exchange telecommunications services. On August 28, 2006, the Administrative Law Judge issued a Procedural Order which stated that Staff shall file an update on ANI's application to cancel its CC&N with any appropriate recommendations no later than September 29, 2006.

On September 1, 2006, Staff was able to contact Raymond Perea, attorney to ANI. On September 5, 2006, Staff received correspondence from ANI's attorney stating that the company requests to withdraw the application for cancellation of its CC&N to provide local exchange telecommunications services in Arizona. ANI was not and is not providing local service to customers in Arizona. Therefore, no customers will be affected. Staff has no objections to this request; therefore, this matter should be withdrawn. ANI's CC&N to Provide Resold IXC Telecommunications Services in the State of Arizona as granted in Docket No. T-02664A-92-0047 should remain valid.

Given the above, Staff recommends that this matter be administratively closed.
