PROCEDURAL ORDER
MODIFYING DECISION NO. 68858
NUNC PRO TUNC

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 28, 2006, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 68858 in this docket. Decision No. 68858 ordered Arizona-American Water Company ("Company") to file with the Commission revised schedules of rates and charges consistent with the schedule set forth in the Decision on pages 41 through 44, and consistent with the discussion in the Decision.

On August 4, 2006, the Company filed a Notice of Filing Revised Tariffs in compliance with Decision No. 68858.

On August 25, 2006, the Company filed another Notice of Filing Revised Tariffs, stating that the purpose of the filing was to correct an error in Decision No. 68858.

On September 7, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Motion for Nunc Pro Tunc Entry. In its Motion, Staff submitted the following as nunc pro tunc entries:

1 Opinion and Order, Decision No. 68858, Page 42, line 7 ½, should read “From 1 to
2 25,000,000 Gallons” not 2,500,000 Gallons; and Opinion and Order, Decision No.
3 68858, Page 42, line 8 ½, should read “Over 25,000,000 Gallons” not 2,500,000
4 Gallons.

5 Decision No. 68858 describes, on page 29, lines 22-24, the Company’s proposal to add a
6 second tier of 25,000,000 gallons/month to its turf irrigation commodity rate so that a portion of the
7 Paradise Valley Country Club’s monthly usage may be subject to the proposed High Block surcharge.
8 Decision No. 68858 states, on page 30, that the Company’s proposal is reasonable and will be
9 adopted.

10 Typographical errors appear on page 42, lines 7 ½ and 8 ½ of the Decision. These lines refer
11 to two-tiered commodity charges for the Paradise Valley Country Club contract rate, with the first
12 tier “From 1 to 2,500,000 Gallons” and the second tier “Over 2,500,000 Gallons.” In accordance
13 with the discussion in the Decision on pages 29-30, the tiers appearing on page 42 should instead
14 read “From 1 to 25,000,000 Gallons” for the first tier and “Over 25,000,000 Gallons” for the second
15 tier.

17 The above-described typographical errors in Decision No. 68858 should be corrected.

18 Staff’s Motion for Nunc Pro Tunc Entry is reasonable and should be granted.

19 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Decision No. 68858 is hereby modified, nunc pro tunc,
20 in order to correct two clerical errors appearing on page 42.

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that page 42, line 7 ½ of Decision No. 68858 is hereby
22 amended, nunc pro tunc, to read “From 1 to 25,000,000 Gallons” instead of “From 1 to 2,500,000


