12 Pursuant to Decision No. 68176, Chaparral City Water Company, Inc. ("Chaparral City"
13 or "Company") submits this Notice of Compliance in the above-captioned matter. Decision No.
14 68176 required Chaparral City to file with Docket Control the results of its meter monitoring for
15 the period June 1, 2005 through June 1, 2006.

16 For the period June 1, 2005 through June 1, 2006, Chaparral City pumped 2,304,106,000
17 gallons of water and sold 2,116,402,000 gallons of water to its customers.¹ The Company's
18 water loss for June 1, 2005 through June 1, 2006 is 8.1%, which is below the amount identified
19 by Staff and the Commission as an acceptable water loss rate of 10%. See the Chaparral City's
20 Water Use Data Sheet, attached hereto as Exhibit A.


