

PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE HEARING FOR THE APPLICATION OF BEAVER DAM WATER COMPANY FOR AN EXTENSION OF ITS CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

Docket No. W-03067A-06-0117

On March 1, 2006, Beaver Dam Water Company ("AWC" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide water service. If the application is granted, the Applicant would be the exclusive provider of water service to the proposed extension area and should be required by the Commission to provide service under rates and charges and terms and conditions established by the Commission. The application, report of the Commission's Utilities Division Staff, and any written exceptions to the staff report prepared by the Applicants are available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission located at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, and at the offices of the Company, and on the internet via the Commission website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-docket function.

The Commission will hold a public hearing on this matter on October 30, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission's offices, at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comment will be taken on the first day of the hearing.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene in the proceedings and participate as a party. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission and send such motion to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record, and which at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g. a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, a competitor, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before October 13, 2006. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. Failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their behalf. You will not, however, receive any further notice of the proceeding unless requested by you. Please check with the Commission for any changes to the scheduled hearing date.


