Dear Chairman Woodall:

As an elected official representing constituents with interest in the Western Maricopa County area, I am writing to recommend approval of a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility (CEC) for the Devers/Palo Verde No 2 high voltage transmission line as applied for by the Southern California Edison Company. There are significant benefits for Maricopa County citizens resulting from construction of the DPV2 transmission lines:

- A new high voltage transmission line between Arizona and California will strengthen the electric grid that supplies our two states.
• The DPV2 transmission line will increase electric reliability for consumers and will facilitate the movement of renewable energy from California to Arizona.
• The proposed line will also allow Arizona based generation assets to sell energy to California residents-creating tax revenue for the State of Arizona.

Additionally, Southern California Edison Company has agreed to remove for consideration the alternative route that was proposed to go through private land in the Harquahala Valley farming area. I opposed this alternative route and support the removal of it from consideration.

I respectfully urge approval by the CEC of the proposed preferred route of the Dever/Palo Verde No. 2 high voltage electric transmission line.
