**SWEEP/WRA'S RESPONSE TO

("WRA") respond to the Procedural Order issued August 28, 2006 as follows.

SWEEP/WRA do not believe that the new proposal set forth by Tucson Electric Power
("TEP") supports any significant delay in the current schedule for the proceedings.


SWEEP/WRA generally support the Response to the Procedural Order filed by Mesquite Power,
LLC, et al. on August 30, 2006. Specifically, SWEEP/WRA agree that the substantive content
and scope of the proposal set forth in the testimony filed by TEP require that a new form and
content of public notice be published by TEP and mailed to its customers. To the extent that the
new form of public notice may generate additional requests for intervention, the procedural dates

1 set forth in the June 1, 2006 Procedural Order may need to be adjusted but any adjustment should
2 be slight.

3 Therefore, SWEEP/WRA support Mesquite's suggestion that the Administrative Law
4 Judge consider an earlier deadline for intervention than would otherwise apply to the issuance of
5 the new form of public notice. If additional requests for intervention actually materialize, a
6 procedural conference can be convened, if necessary, to consider any additional adjustment in
7 the procedural dates established in the June 1, 2006 Procedural Order.
