PROCEDURAL ENTRY

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 10, 2005, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, United States of America, ("BIA" or "Complainant") filed the above-captioned Complaint against Mohave Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Mohave" or "Respondent") with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission").

On September 7, 2006, a Pre-Hearing Conference was held in this matter as scheduled by the Procedural Order issued on August 4, 2006. The BIA, Mohave and the Commission's Utilities Division Staff entered appearances through counsel and discussed procedural issues.

On September 11, 2006, a Settlement Conference Procedural Order was issued setting a settlement conference to commence on September 26, 2006, and informing the parties of procedural requirements related to the settlement conference.


On September 18, 2006, Respondent filed a Notice of Unavailability and Request to Reset Settlement Conference. Respondent stated that all three members of its management staff who would be in a position to negotiate a settlement, subject to the Board of Directors' ratification, will be unavailable to appear personally on the scheduled date, and that the member who would be available by phone would have a time lag for response. Respondent proposed several alternative dates in September and October 2006 for the settlement conference.

1 On September 20, 2006, Complainant filed its Response to the Notice. Complainant stated
2 that it does not object to a continuance of the settlement conference, and provided three dates on
3 which Complainant is available corresponding with Respondent's availability. By Procedural Order,
4 the settlement conference was continued to October 17, 2006.

5 On October 17, 2006, the BIA and Mohave appeared with counsel at the settlement
6 conference. The parties were unable to resolve the issues raised by the Complaint in this proceeding.

7 Accordingly, the presiding Administrative Law Judge will issue a Procedural Order governing
8 further proceedings in this matter.
