STIPULATION


On August 28, 2006, the Arizona Corporation Commission Staff ("Staff") issued a letter of conditional sufficiency commencing the statutory time clock in this proceeding. The letter was conditioned upon the Arizona-American Water Company's (the "Company") agreement to docket volumetric billing determinants satisfactory to Staff that reconcile the proposed volumetric (i.e., water usage) rates to the proposed revenue no later than six weeks from the date of the letter, or by October 11, 2006. The conditional sufficiency letter also memorialized the Staff and Company's agreement that failure to submit the required billing determinants by that date would result in the time clock being immediately suspended until the information was filed.

As of the date of this filing, the Company has not provided to Staff the volumetric billing determinants that reconcile the proposed volumetric rates to the proposed revenue. Accordingly, Staff and Company stipulate to an immediate suspension of the time clock in this case retroactive to October 11, 2006, until such time as the Staff notifies the Commission that it has received volumetric billing determinant information which it finds satisfactory for reconciliation purposes. The Parties also agree that the procedural schedule shall be adjusted by a commensurate time period once Staff notifies the Commission that the information has been obtained from the Company and that it satisfactorily addresses Staff's needs.

1 WHEREFORE, the Staff and the Company respectfully request that the Hearing Division
2 immediately issue a Procedural Order which suspends the time clock in this proceeding retroactive to
3 October 11, 2006 until further notice.
