PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 10, 2006, Southern California Edison Company ("Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Motion for an Amendment of ACC Decision No. 51170 or, in the alternative, a Declaration of No Substantial Change. The Motion is related to the construction of 13 double-circuit towers in Copper Bottom Pass for the Devers-Palo Verde 1, 500kV transmission line.

On July 21, 2006, Sierra Club – Grand Canyon Chapter and the Commission's Utility Division Staff, filed responses to the motion. On August 18, 2006 Applicant filed a reply brief; in the reply SCE amended its original application to encompass a 14th double-circuit tower at the Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station.

On October 17, 2006, the Commission referred this docket to the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") to act as a hearing officer, to consider whether the construction of 14 double-circuit towers constitutes a substantial change from the Certificate of Environmental Compatibility granted in Decision No. 51170.

1 The Commission charged the Committee to recommend appropriate relief including the
2 possibility of authorizing an amendment of the Commission's decision in Decision No. 51170,
3 pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-252. The Commission further charged the Committee to make findings
4 that would support possible remedies, consistent with the Committee's findings. Accordingly,
5 the Chairman of the Committee now issues this Procedural Order pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-
6 101, *et seq.* to govern the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that the hearing in the above-captioned matter shall
8 commence on **December 7, 2006 at 9:30 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the
9 Phoenix Airport Marriott, 1101 North 44th Street, Phoenix, Arizona, 85008, telephone (602)
10 273-7373.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-
12 3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before **November 17, 2006**.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that any objections to motions to intervene must be filed
14 on or before **November 24, 2006**.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Applicant and interveners shall, on or before
16 **November 29, 2006**, file testimony and exhibits with Docket Control, Arizona Corporation
17 Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007; and, electronically submit
18 copies via e-mail to Laurie A. Woodall, Chairman, Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line
19 Siting Committee, laurie.woodall@azag.gov.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Applicants shall provide public notice of the
21 hearing in this matter, in the following form and style, with the heading in no less than 12 pt.
22 type and the body in no less than 10 pt. type:

26 On July 10, 2006, Southern California Edison Company filed with the Arizona
Corporation Commission ("Commission") a motion for an amendment of ACC
Decision No. 51170 or in the alternative, a declaration of no substantial change.
The subject of the motion and subsequent reply is 13 double-circuit structures

1 constructed in Copper Bottom Pass for the Devers-Palo Verde No. 1 500 kV
2 transmission line, and one double-circuit structure erected at the Palo Verde
3 Nuclear Generating Station. The motion and related filings are available for
4 public inspection during regular business hours at the Commission's offices, 1200
5 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, and on the internet via the
6 Commission website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-docket function.

7 On October 17, 2006, the Commission referred this docket to Arizona Power Plant
8 and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") to act as a hearing
9 officer, to consider whether the construction of 14 double-circuit towers
10 constitutes a substantial change from the Certificate of Environmental
11 Compatibility granted in Decision No. 51170.

12 The Commission also charged the Committee to recommend appropriate relief
13 including the possibility of authorizing an amendment of the Commission's
14 decision in Decision No. 51170, pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-252. The Commission
15 further charged the Committee to make findings that would support possible
16 remedies, consistent with the Committee's findings.

17 The Committee will hold a hearing on this matter beginning **December 7, 2006 at**
18 **9:30 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Phoenix Airport Marriott,
19 1101 North 44th Street, Phoenix, Arizona, 85008, telephone (602) 273-7373.
20 Public comment will be taken at the commencement of the hearing. Written
21 public comments may be submitted via e-mail (see
22 <http://www.azcc.gov/utility/cons/index.htm> for instructions), or by mailing a letter
23 referencing Docket No. E-20465A-06-0457, to the Arizona Corporation
24 Commission, Docket Control, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

25 You may have the right to intervene in the proceeding. Intervention shall be in
26 accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be
filed on or before **November 17, 2006**. If you wish to intervene you must file a
written motion to intervene with the Commission and send a copy of the motion to
Applicants or their counsel and to all parties of record. The motion shall, at the
minimum, contain the following:


1. Your name, address, and telephone number and the name, address and
