PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 17, 2006, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for Arbitration Procedure and Approval of Interconnection Agreement pursuant to Section 252(b) of the Communications Act of 1934 as amended by the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the "Act") for approval of an interconnection agreement between Qwest and each of eleven named wireless and paging carriers¹ to implement the ruling of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") *In the Matter of Developing a Unified Intercarrier Compensation Regime, T-Mobile et al. Petition for Declaratory Ruling Regarding Incumbent LEC Wireless Termination Tariffs*, CC Docket 01-92, FCC 05-42 (Rel. Feb. 24, 2006) ("T-Mobile Order").

After filing its petition in this docket, Qwest continued negotiations with the eleven named non-petitioning carriers, and as a result, entered into interconnection agreements with many of the carriers or discovered that interconnection was not possible. Qwest, therefore, moved periodically to dismiss each party with which it either executed an agreement or discovered it could not interconnect.

On May 9, 2006, Qwest filed its Third Amendment to its Application for Arbitration

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1 Procedure and Approval of Interconnection Agreement, Deleting Nextel West Corp. and
2 Answerphone, Inc., stating that "Nextel and Answerphone have discontinued their Type 1 Paging
3 facilities in Arizona." Accordingly, by Procedural Order issued on May 24, 2006, Nextel and
4 Answerphone were dismissed from this proceeding and the caption was amended accordingly.


5 On October 20, 2006, the Commission issued Decision No. 68993, resolving the only
6 remaining issue between the sole remaining parties to the docket, Qwest and Handy Page.

7 On October 25, 2006, Qwest filed its Motion to Re-Open Arbitration with Respect to
8 Answerphone, Inc. Qwest stated that since the dismissal of Answerphone from this proceeding,
9 "Qwest has discovered that Answerphone continues to operate as a wireless provider of paging
10 services, and has continuously been interconnected with Qwest throughout the relevant time periods
11 of this proceeding."

12 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Answerphone shall file a response to Qwest's Motion to
13 Re-Open Arbitration with Respect to Answerphone, Inc. no later than November 16, 2006. If
14 Answerphone fails to file a response by November 16, 2006, Qwest's Motion shall be considered
15 granted and the arbitration for interconnection agreement shall be re-opened.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Arbitrator may rescind, alter, amend, or waive any
17 portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
