

Pursuant to Decision No. 67240, Palo Verde Utilities Company (PVUC) submits the following report setting forth its compliance reporting during the past quarter for the various permits and other compliance reporting obligations associated with the operation of PVUC.

Palo Verde Utilities Company (PVUC) received notification from ADEQ on 9 April 2007 that PVUC reported exceedances in turbidity in excess of the allowable quantity for the fourth quarter of 2006. ADEQ evaluates performance based on alert limits, discharge limits, and technical review criteria. The combination of those parameters resulted in their assessment. The turbidity upsets were the result of a loss of process control of the plant biological system, and the unanticipated failure of flex joints in decant system. PVUC had reported these exceedances to ADEQ while they were happening.

Throughout the first quarter of 2007, the treatment system has produced water that is in full compliance with the permit conditions. In addition, PVUC has instituted additional process control measures as well as equipment repairs to ensure continued compliance.




