PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 4, 2005, the Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a rate increase and to amend Decision No. 67744 (April 7, 2005).

On November 9, 2005, the Commission opened a docket to investigate the unplanned outages during 2005 at the Palo Verde Nuclear Power Generating Station. The Commission also opened a docket to audit the fuel and purchased power practices and costs of APS.

On January 31, 2006, APS filed an Amended Application.

By Procedural Order issued September 18, 2006, the above-referenced matters were consolidated.

1 The hearing commenced October 10, 2006, and is still in progress. On November 24, 2006,
2 the Solar Advocates filed a Motion to Take Notice of the Commission's Final Decision and Order
3 No. 69127 in Docket No. RE-00000C-05-0030, the Record Thereunder, and Certain Other Matters
4 ("Motion"). Additionally, it has been requested that a procedural conference be held to discuss post-
5 hearing issues, including the scheduling of briefs. Accordingly, a procedural conference should be
6 held to hear argument on the Motion, and to discuss post-hearing matters.

7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a Procedural Conference shall be held on **December 6,**
8 **2006, at 1:30 p.m.,**¹ at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona 85007
9 to discuss post-hearing matters and to hear oral argument on the Motion.
