The above Notice indicates that a hearing date is set for January 24, 2007, with a deadline to intervene "no later than November 22, 2002", which is obviously a mistake.

On April 26, 2006, Goodman Water Company ("Goodman" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission for an approximate 152 percent increase in revenue (\$324,607). Under the Company's proposal the typical residential customer, using an average of 5,513 gallons per month, would experience a monthly increase of \$46.97, or 168.25 percent.

The Commission's Utilities Division Staff has not yet made a recommendation regarding the Company's rate increase proposal, and the Commission will determine the appropriate rate relief to be granted based on the evidence of record in this proceeding. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by the Company, Staff, or any intervenors and, therefore, the final rates approved in this docket may be lower or higher than the rates described above. Copies of the application and proposed tariffs are available at the Company's offices at 6340 North Campbell Avenue, Suite 278, Tucson, Arizona, and on the internet via the Commission website ([www.azcc.gov](http://www.azcc.gov)) using the c-docket function.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning January 24, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, Room 222,400 West Congress, Tucson, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission no later than November 22, 20(t) The motion to intervene must be sent to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record, and must contain the following:
