PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 16, 2006, New River Utility Company ("New River" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate" or "CC&N").

On October 6, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Sufficiency Letter in this docket indicating that the application has met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code.

On October 13, 2006, a Procedural Order was issued setting forth filing deadlines and setting the hearing to commence on December 21, 2006 at 10:00 a.m.

On October 23, 2006, an Amended Procedural Order was issued to correct the October 13, 2006, order which inadvertently misstated the Applicant's name.

On November 15, 2006, the parties filed a Proposed Stipulation requesting that the hearing date be reset due to witness unavailability.

Good cause has been shown and accordingly, the hearing should be reset.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing** currently scheduled for December 21, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. is hereby reset to **January 9, 2007 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the timeclock in this matter is hereby extended accordingly.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

2 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
3 ruling at hearing.
