

REQUEST TO INCLUDE PULTE HOME CORPORATION ON SERVICE LIST

Pulte Home Corporation ("Pulte"), through its undersigned counsel, hereby requests that Pulte be included on the service list and copied on all filings, notices and orders for the above-captioned matter.

In support of its request, Pulte states as follows:

1. On April 14, 2004, Johnson Utilities L.L.C. ("Johnson") filed an Application for Extension of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to extend its existing Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to "include an area encompassing the developments known as Sonoran Village and Merrill Ranch."

2. On July 22, 2004, Pulte acquired Merrill Ranch property from Roadrunner Resorts, LLC. The property acquired includes all of the proposed area of extension in Sections 18, 19, 20, and 30 of Township 4 South, Range 9 East, G&SRB&M.

3. On February 25, 2005, Pulte filed an Application for Leave to Intervene in the above-captioned matter.

4. On March 9, 2005, Administrative Law Judge Marc E. Stern approved Pulte's Application for Leave to Intervene.

1 5. On October 25, 2006, the Arizona Corporation Commission
2 (“Commission”) issued Decision No. 68237 granting Johnson’s application for an
3 extension of its CC&N. Decision No. 68237 requires Johnson to accomplish certain
4 compliance items prior to retail water service being provided to any customers in the
5 CC&N extension.

6 6. As the largest landowner in the area of extension of Johnson’s CC&N,
7 Pulte maintains a direct and substantial interest in participating in these proceedings and
8 monitoring Johnson’s achievement of the compliance items listed in Decision No.
9 68237. However, since its Application for Leave to Intervene was granted, Pulte has
10 not been regularly copied on filings, notices and orders submitted in these proceedings.
11 As such, it has been difficult for Pulte to adequately monitor and participate in these
12 proceedings.

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
