Re: Request by Ameritech Communications International, Inc. (ACII) to Cancel its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide competitive resold intrastate toll telecommunications services. Corporate ID# 36-4092071. Docket Number T-03195-A-96-0320.

Ameritech Communications International, Inc. ("ACII") respectfully requests that the Arizona Corporation Commission allow ACII to cancel, without prejudice its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide competitive resold intrastate toll telecommunications services.

On August 27, 1999, ACII was granted the attached by the Arizona Corporation Commission. Consumers are not affected by canceling this service. ACII has not provided or no longer provides local or long distance service in the state of Arizona.

On October 8, 1999, SBC Communications, Inc. merged with Ameritech Communications, Inc. The resulting corporation is known as SBC Communications, Inc. ("SBC"). The SBC subsidiary, known as ACII, currently receives regulatory support from Southwestern Bell Communications Services, Inc. ("SBCS"), the primary SBC subsidiary responsible for providing long distance service.

On December 26, 2002 ACII was dissolved per the attached Certificate of Dissolution from the state of Delaware. In addition, all other subsidiaries and affiliates of ACII were merged into SBCS. Accordingly, ACII no longer requires its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity from the state of Arizona.



ORDER

Open Meeting

BY THE COMMISSION:

Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On June 4, 1996, Ameritech Communications International, Inc ("Applicant") filed with the Commission an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold intrastate toll telecommunications services in Arizona.
2. In Decision No. 58926 (December 22, 1994), the Commission found that resold telecommunications providers ("resellers") were public service corporations subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
3. In Decision No. 59124 (June 23, 1995), the Commission adopted A.A.C. R14-2-1101 through R14-2-1115 to regulate resellers.
4. Applicant is a Delaware corporation, authorized to do business in Arizona since 1996.
5. Applicant is a switchless reseller and in its application stated that it plans to utilize MCIWorldcom as its underlying carrier.
6. On January 26, 1999, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Staff

Report.

7. In the Staff Report, Staff stated that Applicant is a wholly owned subsidiary of Ameritech Corporation. Ameritech Corporation reported stockholders equity of \$8.3 billion as of December 31, 1997. Based on the financial strength of the consolidated entity, Staff believed that Applicant has adequate financial resources to make necessary plant additions or incur operating losses.

8. The Staff Report stated that Applicant has no market power and the reasonableness of its rates would be evaluated in a market with numerous competitors.

9. Staff recommended that:

(a) Applicant's application for a Certificate should be approved without a hearing subject to A.A.C. R14-2-1106.B;

(b) Applicant's intrastate toll service offerings should be classified as competitive pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-1108;

(c) Applicant's competitive services should be priced at the effective rates set forth in Applicant's tariffs and the maximum rates for these services should be the maximum rates proposed by Applicant in its tariffs. The minimum rates for applicant's competitive services should be Applicant's long run incremental costs of providing those services as set forth in A.A.C. R14-2-1109; and

(d) Applicant should be required to comply with the Commission's rules and modify its tariffs to conform with the rules if it is determined there is a conflict between Applicant's tariffs and the Commission's rules.

10. By Procedural Order dated March 18, 1999, the Commission set a deadline of April 23, 1999, for filing exceptions to the Staff Report; requesting that a hearing be set; or requesting intervention as interested parties.

11. Applicant provided notice to interested parties as required in the March 18, 1999 Procedural Order and published notice of its filing as required pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-1104.

12. No exceptions were filed to the Staff Report, nor did any party request that a hearing be set.

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Applicant is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.
2. The Commission has jurisdiction over Applicant and the subject matter of the application.
3. Notice of the application was given in accordance with the law.
4. Applicant's provision of resold intrastate toll services is in the public interest.
5. Applicant is a fit and proper entity to receive a Certificate for providing competitive intrastate toll services as a reseller in Arizona.
6. Staff's recommendations in Findings of Fact No. 9 are reasonable and should be adopted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Application of Ameritech Communications International, Inc. for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for authority to provide competitive intrastate toll services shall be, and the same is hereby granted.



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
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Ameritech Communications International, Inc. shall comply with the Staff recommendations set forth in Findings of Fact No. 9.


