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RE: IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF VERIZON CALIFORNIA INC. TARIFF FILING FOR EXPEDITED APPROVAL OF AN INDIVIDUAL CASE BASE AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISIONING OF DIGITAL CHANNEL SERVICE FOR LA PAZ REGIONAL HOSPITAL (DOCKET NO. T-01846B-07-0007)

On January 5, 2007, Verizon California, Inc. ("Verizon California") filed for expedited approval of tariff revisions consisting of an Individual Case Basis Agreement ("ICB") for the provisioning of the Digital Channel Service ("DCS") for La Paz Regional Hospital ("LPRH"). The term of the Agreement between Verizon California and LPRH is three years from the in-service date (the tariff says from the effective date of the tariff) and the proposed rates are as follows:

The LPRH installed a new phone system and plans to use it for video conferencing and establishing tele-radiology links with all of its clinics. Upon installation of the new phone system, the LPRH experienced problems including faxes that did not work, many phone lines that did not work and a high volume of dropped calls.

Staff understands that installation of Digital Channel Service will alleviate these problems. Staff recommends approval of this filing. Because of the extenuating circumstances in this case (public health and safety), Staff further recommends that the normal thirty-day notice requirement for tariff approval be waived.
