MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On February 2, 2006, in Decision No. 68444, the Commission approved the extension of the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity held by the Goodman Water Company. The Commission's Opinion and Order included three conditions to be complied with subsequent to the entry of the Decision, including the filing of a Pinal County Franchise, a main extension agreement ("MXA"), and a Certificate of Assured Water Supply ("CAWS").

Following the issuance of the Decision, the owners and developers of the land to be included within the extension area (the "Extension Area") proceeded to prepare the plat submittals required by Pinal County, and the water company renewed its request to the

1 Pinal County Board of Supervisors for an expansion of its County Franchise. Thereafter,  
2 on March 1, 2006, the Goodman Water Company received (and filed with the  
3 Commission) the necessary County Franchise for the Extension Area.

4  
5 Concurrently, the landowners and the developer undertook the extensive rezoning  
6 and development work requisite for the development of the property. The Extension Area  
7 is located in southern Pinal County, contiguous with the northern Pima County boundary.  
8 Pima County provides wastewater treatment services to the existing customers of  
9 Goodman Water Company, and is contractually committed to serve any future customers  
10 located within the existing CC&N of the water company. The landowners and the  
11 developer had believed until recently (and had been so informed by officials in Pima  
12 County), that the Pima County Wastewater Management Agency ("PCWWMA") would  
13 also provide wastewater treatment services to customers located within the Extension  
14 Area.

15  
16 Notwithstanding Pima County's initial representations, the landowners and the  
17 developer learned early this Winter that the PCWWMA had reversed its decision to  
18 provide sewer services, and that it would no longer agree to provide utility services in  
19 southern Pinal County. Since that time, the Goodman Water Company has been stymied  
20 in its efforts to produce the CAWS or the MXA because the developer's subdivision plat  
21 itself cannot be finalized until the wastewater utility issues is resolved.



23 The developer has since engaged the engineering firm Westland Resources to  
24 design a wastewater treatment plant, and to undertake a CAAG (Central Arizona  
25 Association of Governments) 208 Plan amendment; and it has met with Pinal County  
26 officials to obtain their concurrence for siting a subregional wastewater treatment plan  
27 within the Extension Area. Having satisfied itself that the developer is making progress  
28 in this regard, and that the necessary approvals can be obtained within one year, the

1 Goodman Water Company has resolved to support the developer by filing this request to  
2 extend the time periods associated with the MXA and the CAWS that are contained in  
3 Decision No. 68444.

4  
5 Consequently, Goodman Water Company respectfully moves that the submission  
6 dates set forth in Decision No. 68444 for the Main Extension Agreement and the  
7 Certificate of Assured Water Supply be revised to February 2, 2008.


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
