IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF ARIZONA-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY, AN ARIZONA CORPORATION, FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE SERVICE AREA UNDER ITS EXISTING CERTIFICATES OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE WATER AND SEWER UTILITY SERVICES IN ITS AGUA FRIA WATER AND WASTEWATER DISTRICTS.

PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 12, 2006, Arizona-American Water Company ("Applicant" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an extension of its existing Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide public water and public wastewater utility service to its Agua Fria Water and Wastewater Districts in various parts of Maricopa County, Arizona.

On May 9, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") issued a notice of insufficiency which indicated that the Company's application had not met the sufficiency requirements of A.A.C. R14-2-411(C), and A.A.C. R14-2-610(C).

On August 1, 2006, Staff issued a second notice of insufficiency.

On September 15, 2006, Staff issued a letter of administrative completeness to the Company.

On September 19, 2006, by Procedural Order, the proceeding was scheduled for a hearing on November 20, 2006.

On October 18, 2006, the Company filed certification that it had provided public notice of the proceeding pursuant to the Commission's Procedural Order.

On November 7, 2006, the Company filed a Motion for an Indefinite Continuance ("Motion") pending the outcome of another proceeding in Docket No. W-01303A-05-0718, a proceeding concerning issues which are somewhat related. The Company, in its Motion, requested the hearing

1 scheduled on November 20, 2006, be held to take public comment only and the evidentiary portion of
2 the proceeding continued. The company further indicated that Staff was in agreement with its
3 Motion and further agreed to the suspension of the time-clock rule.

4 On November 20, 2006, a full public hearing was convened before a duly authorized
5 Administrative Law Judge of the Commission at its offices in Phoenix, Arizona. The Company and
6 Staff appeared with counsel. Public comment was taken and the Company's Motion was granted
7 with the time-clock suspended.

8 On November 20, 2006, the Company filed a request to reconvene the evidentiary portion of
9 the proceeding.

10 Accordingly, the hearing should be reconvened.

11 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing** shall recommence on **April 3, 2007, at**
12 **9:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West**
13 **Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.**

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if any **additional documents and associated exhibits will**
15 **be presented at hearing on behalf of Staff, they shall be reduced to writing and filed on or**
16 **before, 4:00 p.m. on March 16, 2007.**

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **objections to any additional documents and**
18 **associated exhibits to be presented at hearing by Applicant shall be reduced to writing and filed**
19 **on or before 4:00 p.m. on March 26, 2007.**

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
21 amend, or waive any portion of the Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
22 ruling at hearing.
