

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF COMCAST PHONE OF ARIZONA, LLC DBA COMCAST DIGITAL PHONE FOR A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE RE-SOLD LONG DISTANCE, RE-SOLD LOCAL EXCHANGE, FACILITIES BASED LONG DISTANCE AND FACILITIES BASED LOCAL EXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN ARIZONA.

Docket No. T-04293A-04-0870 On December 6, 2004, Comcast Phone of AZ, LLC dba Comcast Digital Phone, ("Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive facilities-based long distance, facilities-based local exchange and private line service telecommunications services in the State of Arizona. The Commission's Utilities Division Staff has recommended approval of the Company's application. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by the Company, Staff, or any intervenors, and the Company will be required to provide this service under the rates and charges and terms and conditions established by the Commission. Copies of the application, report of the Commission's Utilities Division Staff, and any written exceptions to the report of the Commission's Utilities Division Staff filed by the Company are available at the Company's offices 1500 Market Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19102 and on the internet via the Commission website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-docket function.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning March 1, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission no later than February 16, 2007. The motion to intervene must be sent to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record, and must contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different from the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and providing public comment on the application or from filing written comments in the record of the case. You will not receive any further notice of this proceeding unless you request it.
