In this docket, Midvale Telephone Exchange ("Midvale") filed an application for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide local telephone service in a proposed new area in Yavapai County, Arizona, to be included in Midvale's Millsite Exchange. In addition, Midvale requested that the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") approve two-way extended area service ("EAS") between the Millsite Exchange and Table Top Telephone Company's ("Table Top" or the "Company") Inscription Canyon Ranch Exchange, and between the Millsite Exchange and Qwest Corporation's ("Qwest") Prescott local calling area¹ (the "Prescott Local Calling Area"). Table Top and Qwest requested and were granted intervention in this docket.

Table Top's Inscription Canyon Ranch Exchange is contiguous to a portion of Qwest's Prescott Exchange, and Table Top provides one-way EAS for its customers in the Inscription Canyon Ranch Exchange to Qwest prefixes in the Prescott Local Calling Area. At the hearing in this docket held on August 20, 2003, Table Top requested that the Commission approve two-way

1 EAS between the Inscription Canyon Ranch Exchange and Qwest prefixes in the Prescott Local
2 Calling Area. However, in exceptions filed on October 30, 2003, Table Top withdrew its request
3 for two-way EAS, and no party in this docket objected to the withdrawal of the Company's
4 request.

5 On November 10, 2003, the Commission issued Decision 66510 in this docket. Among
6 other things, the Commission ordered the following:

7 1. That the EAS portion of Midvale's application and Table Top's request for two-
8 way EAS be set for additional hearings;

9 2. That Qwest, Midvale and Table Top submit documentation to Staff so that Staff
10 can evaluate the costs associated with implementing two-way EAS within 30 days of the date of
11 Decision 66510;

12 3. That Midvale and Table Top poll their current and potential customers, in a format
13 approved by Staff, to determine if those customers would be willing to bear the increased
14 financial burden of supporting two-way EAS to each others exchanges and to Qwest's Local
15 Calling Area, and file affidavits stating the results of those polls within 90 days of the date
16 Decision 66510; and


17 4. That if Midvale or Table Top failed to comply with any of these time frames, then
18 their respective requests for two-way EAS would be dismissed without further order of the
19 Commission and the docket administratively closed.

20 Since Table Top has withdrawn its request for two-way EAS, the Company does not
21 believe that any of the time frames or requirements set forth in Decision 66510 apply to Table
22 Top. Accordingly, Table Top does not intend to submit documentation to Staff regarding the
23 costs of implementing two-way EAS, poll current or potential customers regarding their interest
24 in EAS, or participate in further hearings in this docket.


