**NOTICE OF FILING SURVIVAL

Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") hereby files the attached agreement captioned "SURVIVAL OF CERTAIN AGREEMENTS" (the "Survival Agreement").

As stated in the Survival Agreement, Qwest and Covad filed a new interconnection agreement with the Commission on June 30, 2006 (the "New ICA"), in compliance with the order of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") in the instant arbitration proceeding. The Survival Agreement clarifies the intent of Qwest and DIECA Communications, Inc. d/b/a/ Covad Communications Company ("Covad") with respect to the survival of certain agreements and amendments that were previously entered into between them and which are listed therein ("Surviving Agreements"). Notwithstanding the New ICA, the intent of the parties, as expressed in the Survival Agreement, is that the Surviving Agreements remain operative for their stated terms, or if not specified, the life of the New ICA.

These amendments and agreements were previously filed with and approved by the Commission, with the exception of the Commercial Line Sharing Agreement, which is the

2 Commission.¹ Qwest and Covad have been operating, and continue to operate, under the
3 Surviving Agreements.

4 The Survival Agreement is now filed for approval by the Commission.



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**SURVIVAL OF CERTAIN AGREEMENTS
for the State of Arizona**

This Agreement regarding the Survival of Certain Agreements ("Agreement") is between DIECA Communications, Inc. d/b/a Covad Communications Company ("CLEC"), a Virginia corporation, and Qwest Corporation ("Qwest"), a Colorado corporation (collectively, the "Parties").

On April 21, 1999, the Arizona Corporation Commission approved an Interconnection Agreement between the Parties, for service in the State of Arizona, as referenced in Docket Nos: T-01051B-99-0142, T-03632A-99-0142, Decision No. 61642 ("Pre-existing ICA").

The Parties entered into a new Interconnection Agreement, for services in the State of Arizona, that was filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission on June 30, 2006, as referenced in Docket Nos. T-03632A-04-0425, T-01051B-04-0425 ("New ICA"). Upon approval by the Commission, the New ICA replaced the Pre-existing ICA; and

The Parties concur that certain agreements (listed below) are to survive the termination of the Pre-existing ICA, and will continue to remain operative as set forth therein for their stated terms or, if not specified, for the life of the New ICA. These agreements were previously filed with and approved by the Commission.




