PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On April 14, 2006, Eschelon Telecom of Arizona, Inc. ("Eschelon" or "Complainant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a complaint against Qwest Corporation ("Qwest" or "Respondent") stating that Qwest has refused to provide both repairs for disconnects in error and the capability to expedite orders for unbundled loops under the repair and expedite language of the Qwest-Eschelon Interconnection Agreement ("ICA").

On August 16, 2006, a Procedural Order was issued setting a hearing on the complaint.

On January 11, 2007, a Procedural Order was issued modifying the procedural schedule as jointly requested by Complainant, Respondent and the Commission's Utilities Division Staff.

On February 14, 2007, a telephonic procedural conference was held at the parties' request. Counsel for Eschelon, Qwest and the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") participated. Counsel for Eschelon and Qwest stated their intent to docket a settlement agreement by February 23, 2007, and requested that the hearing be continued pending Staff's response to the settlement agreement. Staff stated that it intends to file a response to any settlement agreement within two weeks of its docketing.

The parties' request for a continuance of the hearing is reasonable under the circumstances and should be granted.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **pre-hearing conference** currently set to be held on  
2 **February 16, 2007, at 2:00 p.m.** is hereby **continued pending further notice.**

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **hearing** in this matter currently set to commence on  
4 **February 20, 2007** is hereby **continued pending further notice.**

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **settlement agreement** to be filed by Complainant and  
6 Respondent shall be filed by **February 23, 2007, or** in the alternative, Complainant shall file a  
7 **request for procedural conference** by that date.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission's Utilities Division Staff shall file a  
9 **response** to any settlement agreement by **March 9, 2007.** The response shall indicate whether the  
10 Utilities Division Staff has any objection to the relief requested in the settlement agreement, and if so,  
11 shall include a request for procedural conference.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
13 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the  
14 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
16 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.

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
