As to the latter, that docket has nothing to do with the Electric Competition Rules, and thus Sempra does not seek intervention therein.

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2. Sempra's interest in the latter three proceedings mentioned above are not adequately and sufficiently represented by any party currently involved in these matters.

3. The granting of intervenor status to Sempra will not result in delay in the proceedings or cause the issues to be resolved therein to be unduly broadened.


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5. Sempra is willing to accept electronic service of all documents.
