



**PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING

On December 28, 2006, Litchfield Park Service Company ("LPSCO" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an accounting order authorizing the deferral of costs associated with efforts to address the potential contamination of portions of its water supply. LPSCO is not seeking an increase in its rates at this time, but is seeking approval from the Commission to defer costs for consideration in a future rate case. The Commission's Utilities Division Staff has not yet made a recommendation regarding the Company's application, and the Commission is not bound by the proposals made by the Company, Staff, or any intervenors. The Commission will issue a decision regarding LPSCO's application following consideration of testimony and evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing. Copies of the application are available at the Company's offices at 12725 W. Indian School Rd., Ste. D101, Avondale, AZ 85323, and the Commission's offices at 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona, for public inspection during regular business hours and on the internet via the Commission website ([www.azcc.gov](http://www.azcc.gov)) using the e-docket function.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning April 5, 2007, at 9:30 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted via email (visit <http://www.azcc.gov/utility/cons/index.htm> for instructions), or by mailing a letter referencing Docket Number E-04204A-06-0783 to: Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you would like to intervene, you must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, and you must send copies of the motion to the Company or its counsel, and to all parties of record in the case. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. Your name, address, and telephone number, and the name, address, and the telephone number of any party upon whom documents are to be served in your place, if desired.
2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, etc.)
3. A statement certifying that a copy of your motion to intervene

has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before March 12, 2007. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any customer from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such customer's own behalf.
