RUCO'S APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

I.

15 The RESIDENTIAL UTILITY CONSUMER OFFICE ("RUCO") hereby applies to the
16 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an Order granting it leave to intervene in
17 the above-captioned proceeding.

II.

19 RUCO was established by the enactment of Arizona Revised Statutes, Section 40-461,
20 *et seq.*, for the purpose of representing residential utility consumers in matters before the
21 Commission concerning regulated public service corporations.

III.

23 Arizona Revised Statutes, Section 40-464.A.2., specifically provides that the Director of
24 RUCO may do the following:

1 Prepare and present briefs, arguments, proposed rates or orders
2 and intervene or appear on behalf of residential utility consumers
3 before hearing officers and the Corporation Commission as a party
4 in interest and also participate as a party in interest pursuant to
5 Section 40-254 in proceedings relating to rate making or rate
6 design and involving public service corporations.

7 IV.

8 The residential utility consumers will be directly and substantially affected by a Decision
9 or Order of the Commission in this matter, therefore, it is necessary and proper that RUCO
10 intervene in the proceeding.

11 V.


12 In order to fulfill its statutory obligation to protect the residential utility consumers of this
13 State, RUCO must thoroughly examine the materials presented by the Company, and must
14 cross-examine witnesses appearing on behalf of the Company and any other parties.
15 Additionally, RUCO may present testimony and exhibits of its own in any hearings conducted
16 by the Commission in this matter.


