THIRD INSUFFICIENCY LETTER

Dear Mr. Rockwell:

The application of Mohawk Utility Company (“Mohawk”) to extend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, Docket No. W-02341A-06-0040, has not met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code (“A.A.C.”). Staff remains concerned about sufficient storage for current customers and about sufficient water to serve the proposed areas.

Please provide the following information:

1. A letter from the Arizona Department of Water Resources (“ADWR”) confirming that an analysis of water supply, or any other ADWR approval is not required because Mohawk would be using surface water to serve the extension areas.
2. The amended contract with Welton-Mohwak Irrigation and Drainage District (“the District”) which would serve to confirm availability of sufficient water to serve the extension areas and that the District contract with Mohawk reflects the extension areas. (Reference page 6, paragraph 5, Boundaries of Mohawk Service in current contract.)


