

ON OCTOBER 6, 2006, THE ARIZONA CORPORATION COMMISSION ("COMMISSION") STAFF FILED A COMPLAINT AND PETITION FOR AN ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE ("COMPLAINT") AGAINST CARL HARVEY, DBA GOLDEN CORRIDOR WATER COMPANY ("GCWC") FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH WATER QUALITY AND SERVICE STANDARDS. ON DECEMBER 5, 2006, THE COMMISSION ISSUED DECISION NO. 69166 WHICH DIRECTED THE HEARING DIVISION TO CONDUCT FURTHER PROCEEDINGS IN THIS MATTER. ON FEBRUARY 8, 2007, THE EVIDENTIARY PORTION OF THE HEARING CONVENED, BUT WAS NOT COMPLETED. COPIES OF THE COMPLAINT AND RESPONSES FILED BY THE COMPANY WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE COMPANY'S OFFICES AT POST OFFICE BOX 486, RUSHVILLE, INDIANA, 46173-0486 AND ON THE INTERNET VIA THE COMMISSION WEBSITE(WWW.AZCC.GOV) USING THE E-DOCKET FUNCTION.

THE COMMISSION WILL HOLD A SECOND PORTION OF THE HEARING ON THIS MATTER ON **MARCH 19, 2007, AT 1:00P.M.**, AT THE COMMISSION'S OFFICES, 1200 WEST WASHINGTON STREET, PHOENIX, ARIZONA. PUBLIC COMMENTS WILL BE TAKEN ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE HEARING. THE LAW PROVIDES FOR AN OPEN PUBLIC HEARING AT WHICH, UNDER APPROPRIATE CIRCUMSTANCES, INTERESTED PARTIES MAY INTERVENE. INTERVENTION SHALL BE PERMITTED TO ANY PERSON ENTITLED BY LAW TO INTERVENE AND HAVING A DIRECT AND SUBSTANTIAL INTEREST IN THE MATTER. PERSONS DESIRING TO INTERVENE MUST FILE A WRITTEN MOTION TO INTERVENE WITH THE COMMISSION NO LATER THAN **MARCH 10, 2007**. THE MOTION TO INTERVENE MUST BE SENT TO THE COMPANY OR IT'S COUNSEL AND TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD, AND MUST CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING:

1. THE NAME, ADDRESS, AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE PROPOSED INTERVENOR AND OF ANY PARTY UPON WHOM SERVICE OF DOCUMENTS IS TO BE MADE IF DIFFERENT FROM THE INTERVENOR.
2. A SHORT STATEMENT OF THE PROPOSED INTERVENOR'S INTEREST IN THE PROCEEDING (E.G., A CUSTOMER OF THE COMPANY, A SHAREHOLDER OF THE COMPANY, ETC.)
3. A STATEMENT CERTIFYING THAT A COPY OF THE MOTION TO INTERVENE HAS BEEN MAILED TO THE COMPANY OR IT'S COUNSEL AND TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD IN THE CASE.

THE GRANTING OF INTERVENTION, AMONG OTHER THINGS, ENTITLES A PARTY TO PRESENT SWORN EVIDENCE AT THE HEARING AND TO CROSS-EXAMINE OTHER WITNESSES. HOWEVER, FAILURE TO INTERVENE WILL NOT PRECLUDE ANY INTERESTED PERSON OR ENTITY FROM APPEARING AT THE HEARING AND PROVIDING PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE APPLICATION OR FROM FILING WRITTEN COMMENTS IN THE RECORD OF THE CASE. YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE ANY FURTHER NOTICE OF THIS PROCEEDING UNLESS YOU REQUEST IT. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS REGARDING THE COMPLAINT, YOU MAY CONTACT THE COMPANY AT 520 840-0489. IF YOU WISH TO FILE WRITTEN COMMENTS ON THE COMPLAINT OR WANT FURTHER INFORMATION ON INTERVENTION YOU MAY CONTACT THE CONSUMER SERVICES SECTION OF THE COMMISSION AT 1200 WEST WASHINGTON STREET, PHOENIX, ARIZONA 85007, OR CALL 1-800-222-7000. THE COMMISSION DOES NOT DISCRIMINATE ON THE BASIS OF DISABILITY IN ADMISSION TO IT'S PUBLIC MEETINGS.
