I understand that the application in this matter was filed with Docket Control at the Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) on March 2, 2007. I received a copy of the application from the ACC on March 5, 2007. By my calculations, the 180-day period specified by A.R.S. § 40-360.04(D) ("within one hundred and eighty days after the application has been filed with or *referred to* the committee") extends through September 1, 2007.

The notice of hearing required by A.R.S. § 40-360.04(A) should be published by March 15, 2007. I have requested that you arrange for the preparation and publication of the notice of hearing, and the notice to the affected areas of jurisdiction and to other entities I previously identified to your office. It is my understanding that the applicant will also prepare and post roadway signs and other notices indicating the date, time, and address of the hearing at locations which you will identify during the hearing.

The first hearing date shall be held not less than thirty days, nor more than sixty days after the date that notice is first given. A.A.C. R14-3-208(B). I requested that you confer with Staff of the Utilities Division of the ACC and any known interveners to determine some mutually convenient date for the hearing. I understand that the dates of May 1 and 2, 2007 at 9:30 a.m. with an evening public comment session at 6:30 p.m. on May 1 are convenient for the parties. These dates are also acceptable for the members of the Line Siting Committee.

I requested that you arrange for a location for the hearing in the general area where the transmission line is to be located. I understand that you have made arrangements for the hearing of May 1, 2007, to be held at The Hampton Inn, 1791 Sycamore Avenue, Kingman, Arizona 86409; telephone: (928) 692-0200, starting at 9:30 a.m., with an evening public comment session starting at 6:30 p.m., and continuing on May 2, 2007 at 9:30 a.m.

Please make arrangements for the tape-recording of the hearings, and any public comment sessions, or the preparation of expedited transcripts, to ensure the Line Siting Committee's minutes are available for public inspection, as required by A.R.S. § 38-431.01(D).

Please contact Michael Kearns, Chief Finance Officer of the Arizona Corporation Commission (602-542-0657), to advise him of the applicant's position concerning reimbursement of the Line Siting Fund, should the expenses of the hearing exceed the application fee.
