PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 27, 2004, the Arizona Corporation Commission's ("Commission") Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") initiated a generic investigatory docket to examine preferred carrier arrangements and other potential anti-competitive practices by telecommunications providers and other entities.

A number of comments have been received from various telecommunications providers since this generic docket was opened.

On July 17, 2007, Accipiter Communications, Inc. ("Accipiter") filed a Motion for a Procedural Conference to Establish a Procedural Schedule and Evidentiary Hearings.

On August 31, 2007, a Procedural Order was issued scheduling a procedural conference for October 9, 2007.

The procedural conference was held, as scheduled, on October 9, 2007. During the procedural conference, various suggestions were made and discussed regarding the procedural handling of the docket.

On November 6, 2007, Staff filed an Issues List that was served on telecommunications providers and other interested parties. Staff requested that responses be filed by no later than December 21, 2007.

On November 9, 2007, the Arizona Local Exchange Carriers Association ("ALECA") filed a Request to Extend Deadline for Responses to Issues List. To date, no opposition to ALECA's

1 extension request has been filed.

2 Staff's Issues List, as well as prior Procedural Orders, were served on an extensive list of
3 telecommunications providers and other entities. The attached service list has been edited to reflect
4 mail returned as undeliverable and other requests for service list changes. In order to further reduce
5 the service list to persons and entities that have an interest in this docket, interested parties will be
6 required to file a written request to remain on the service list by January 2, 2008. Such filings should
7 be submitted to the Commission's Docket Control Division with the required number of copies. Any
8 party on the service list that fails to file such a request will be removed from the master service list
9 and will not receive subsequent filings made in the docket.

10 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **ALECA's Request to Extend Deadline for Responses**
11 **to Issues List is granted, and responses to the Issues List shall be filed by no later than**
12 **February 1, 2008.**

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **parties on the service list who wish to continue to**
14 **receive copies of filings in this docket shall file, by no later than January 2, 2008, an affirmative**
15 **statement indicating their interest in remaining on the service list and a current address where**
16 **service filings should be sent. Failure to file an affirmative statement by January 2, 2008 will**
17 **result in removal from the service list in this docket¹.**

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
19 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
20 hearing.
