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

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

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1 **SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY GIVEN BY SCOTT WAGNER ON BEHALF OF**

4 **I. DIRECT TESTIMONY FILED ON JANUARY 24, 2007**

5 Mr. Wagner testified to the following matters:

6 1. The need for construction of a surface water treatment plant for the area
7 within which Intervernors' lands lie, at the earliest possible moment at the least cost to
8 both the consumers and landowners it will serve.

9 2. The need for alternative water supply sources to be made available prior to
10 construction of the surface water treatment plant so that Intervenors can honor the
11 commitments they have made to the City of Surprise and retail operators and other end
12 users in a timely manner.

13 Mr. Wagner asks the Commission to use its good offices and authority to require
14 Arizona American Water Company ("AAWC") and the Maricopa County Water District
15 Number One ("MWD") to focus on developing a coordinated regional potable
16 groundwater system as well as the construction of an efficient and cost effective surface
17 water treatment plant.

18 **II. SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY FILED ON MARCH 12, 2007**

19 Mr. Wagner testified to the failure of the witnesses for AAWC and MWD to
20 address the issues raised in his Direct Testimony concerning development of a
21 coordinated regional potable groundwater system. He asks the Commission to use its
22 good offices and authority to require AAWC and MWD to act cooperatively in
23 developing such a coordinated system instead of the competing potable groundwater
24 systems they are now requiring because well spacing and quality factors in the local
25 groundwater systems are likely to prohibit such development.
