MT TIPTON WATER CO, INC HAS REQUESTED THE ARIZONA CORPORATION COMMISSION SET A HEARING TO DETERMINE IF A \$10.00 PER MONTH EMERGENCY SURCHARGE PER METERED CUSTOMER AND A 50% INCREASE PER 1,000 GALLONS FOR ITS BULK WATER COMMODITY CHARGE SHOULD BE GRANTED. THE HEARING WILL BEGIN @ THE COMMISSION'S OFFICES @ 1200 WEST WASHINGTON STREET, PHOENIX AZ ON DECEMBER 17TH, 2003 @ 10:00AM. INTERESTED PARTIES MAY INTERVENE. Should the above be approved, the \$10.00 per mo surcharge will replace the current \$5.00 per month pro-rata charge in effect. Emergency rates that are approved will remain in effect until approval of pending Rate Increase Application #W-02105A-03-0303 (copy available for member review @ Company Office - 15996 N Ironwood Drive) prepared by our Accountants (scheduled for Hearing 03-25-04) which asks for approximately a 25% overall increase to current Tariff Rate Schedule.
