

On January 28, 2002, Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP" or "Company"), filed an application requesting an extension of the compliance dates in certain of the Arizona Corporation Commission's ("Commission") Electric Competition Rules, and for any modification to the Settlement Agreement approved in Commission Decision No. 62103 deemed necessary in connection with its request. The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning June 10, 2002, at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. Public Comments will be taken in Phoenix on the first day of hearing.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission. That motion must be sent to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record, and must, at the minimum, contain the following:

(Over)

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, etc.)
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C.R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before May 7, 2002. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any person from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such person's own behalf.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings.
