**MOTION OF ARIZONA INDEPENDENT SCHEDULING ADMINISTRATOR
ASSOCIATION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE**

Pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R14-3-105, the Arizona Independent
Scheduling Administrator Association ("Az ISA") hereby moves the Commission for leave to
intervene in the above-captioned proceedings.

Arizona Corporation Commission
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1. The Az ISA is a voluntary, non-profit Arizona corporation organized in September 1998 as an independent electric transmission scheduling administrator to support implementation of a competitive retail electric market in Arizona through the facilitation of open, non-discriminatory transmission access on the interconnected transmission system. The Az ISA is to serve in this capacity on an interim basis pending formation of a regional transmission organization that is expected to assume such duties in conjunction with its administration of the regional wholesale electric market. The Az ISA operates pursuant to a tariff and contracts approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.
2. By order issued June 18, 2003 in the above-captioned consolidated proceeding, the Arizona Corporation Commission ordered that a hearing be held to consider the continuation of the Az ISA. As the organization that is the subject of this inquiry, the Az ISA has a direct and immediate interest in the subject proceedings that cannot be adequately represented by any other party. Accordingly, it requests that it be granted intervenor status with full rights thereof. Az ISA does not intend to file any direct testimony but reserves its right to submit rebuttal testimony upon review of the direct testimony filed herein.
3. Az ISA requests that the undersigned individual be added to the official service list herein. Az ISA further requests that all pleadings filed in this docket, specifically including all testimony and related exhibits filed herein, be served upon the undersigned representative of the Az ISA at the following address:
