

(GCSECA) submits this letter in support of the testimony filed by Larry D. Huff on behalf of the Arizona Electric Power Cooperative ("AEPSCO") on July 28, 2003 in the Arizona Independent Scheduling Administrator ("AISA") Hearing matter.


