The information requested by Commissioner Gleason at Friday's hearing is enclosed. The enclosed costs were for the services of outside attorneys and consultants that were required for the AISA's filing and maintenance of the AISA Protocols Manual, pro forma transmission and scheduling coordinator agreements, and tariff with the FERC. The AISA started charging for services under its tariff May 3, 2001.

The total to date FERC related costs, not including corporate attorney costs, is \$833,989.27. These data were obtained from the AISA accounting records. The AISA financial records are reviewed monthly by a CPA and are posted monthly on the AISA web site at www.az-isa.org. As a cost saving measure, the AISA is transitioning to quarterly accounting.
