On March 6, 2007, ICR Water Users Association, Inc. ("Applicant") filed an application ("Application") with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. W-028A-07-0139 for authority to borrow \$100,000 from the National Bank of Arizona to finance capital improvements and repairs within the Applicant's service territory. The Commission may act on the Application with or without a hearing. The Application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the Commission's offices at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007; or at the offices of the Applicant, 848 N. Hwy 88, Suite A, Chino Valley, AZ 86323.
Intervention in the Commission's proceedings on the Application shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in this matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a Motion to Intervene with the Commission which must be served upon Applicant and which, at a minimum, shall contain the following information:
1. The name, address and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor;
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding;
3. Whether the proposed intervenor desires a formal evidentiary hearing on the Application and the reasons for such a hearing; and
4. A statement certifying that a copy of the Motion to Intervene has been mailed to Applicant.
The granting of Motions to Intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all Motions to Intervene must be filed on, or before, the 15th day after this notice.
